## BAPTISMS

## Dear Parent(s),

You are about to make a very important step with your child, a step that is not to be taken lightly. In the Sacrament of Baptism, we celebrate our new life in Christ, we become members of the Body of Christ-the church. When a child is baptized, the parents make a commitment to provide their child with a Catholic Christian upbringing, as well as live and practice their own Catholic faith.

- The Priest interviews the family by appointment.
- A Registration Form is completed by the parents.
a. The mother's maiden name is required.
b. If the couple is not registered at Assumption Church, the couple is required to obtain a letter of permission from their parish.
c. There is a $\$ 60$ Fee to Assumption Church.
d. It is customary to offer a "stipend" to the Celebrant on the day of the ceremony (this can be any amount deemed appropriate - make checks payable to the Celebrant). We suggest placing the stipend in a "thank you" card and handing it to the Celebrant after the ceremony.
e. Request a family photo for our records (this assists the Celebrant in identifying the family, immediately).
f. The parish will provide the baptismal candle and stole the day of the ceremony.
- Baptismal dates:
a. $3^{\text {rd }}$ Saturday of each month at 10am.
- Godparent requirements:
a. Only an active, fully initiated Catholic may act as a Godparent. A Godparent must be 16 years of age or older and must have received all Sacraments: Baptism, First Eucharist, Confirmation and if married, the Sacrament of Marriage.
- Baptismal class (required to be taken by the parents and godparents)
A. Baptismal Class is offered:
a. The $\mathbf{1}^{\text {st }}$ Saturday of each month at 10 a.m., Zoomed; call the office for details.
B. The class lasts approximately an hour to an hour and a half. If the class is taken at another Catholic parish, a letter of completion is required to be submitted to the office prior to the Baptismal day.
- All requirements must be met at least a week prior to the baptism.
